

**Sunday 16th March**



Hosted by The Vintage Sports Car Club of South Australia Inc., (VSCC), the Historic Motor Vehicle Gathering was conceived to showcase vintage and veteran vehicles to the public as over the years there had been a decline in outings for many of them.

March 2008 saw the inaugural display in the Adelaide Parklands. Car clubs were invited to participate by having runs which ended at the designated display area. Almost 100 pre-1931 vehicles from various clubs were on show. This number, bolstered by the inclusion of some younger ones, was achieved at each of the subsequent annual events held in the Parklands.

As the Parklands site is now being used by the South Australian Government, the display has been moved to the Barratt Reserve at West Beach. This March will be the 18th consecutive running of the Historic Motor Vehicle Gathering, which now includes classic vehicles too; and incorporates a display of operating stationary engines.

Entry is free for owners who wish to display their vehicles. It is also free for spectators.
